Camp Pentalouan

Please put your name on everything!

Bring old clothes that you don't mind getting wet and dirty!

Pack ALL gear in a suitcase, gear bag, duffel, or heavy-duty garbage bag.

Bedding	Clothing
Sleeping bag	2 pairs of shoes – make sure they are comfy
OR twin size fitted sheet, sheet, and blanket.	At least 4 pairs of socks – it's nice to put on dry socks if your feet get wet
Pillow and pillow case, if desired	1 shirt and pair of pants per day, plus 1 extra set
	Warm jacket, extra sweaters, sweatshirts, light-weight gloves, hat

Raincoat or poncho – VERY, VERY important. We go rain or shine!	Washcloth and towel	Toothbrush and toothpaste

Large plastic bag for dirty clothes	Camera – clearly labeled
Medications - Must be turned into Student Services TWO days before departure.	Bug lotion – NO SPRAY
